The Board of Directors of Covenant Christian High School has established the following criteria for admission. Because we have high expectations of our students, it is important that you consider these carefully.

- A. Academically, we require that our students have:
 - 1. a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale during their last year of school
 - 2. minimal math readiness for Algebra I
 - 3. basic competency as demonstrated by their ability to write the application essay
 - 4. a composite score in at least the 50th percentile on a nationally standardized test
- B. Spiritually, we expect our students to:
 - 1. have a relationship with God through Jesus Christ or at least be open to the idea
 - 2. relate to other students and staff in a manner consistent with scriptures
- C. Attitudinally, we think our students should:
 - 1. want to be at Covenant
 - 2. demonstrate a cooperative spirit
 - 3. take their educational responsibilities seriously.

If you believe your son or daughter meets the above requirements, we invite you to apply for admission to Covenant Christian High School. **For Full-time Students** - The following checklist should serve to guide you through the application process. Please check items off as you proceed. We will not begin to process your application until all seven parts have been received.

- ___ 1. Completed parent **and** student sections of the application
- ___ 2. A copy of the student's birth certificate
- ___ 3. Grade transcripts from the previous school
(You may submit copies of grade cards until transcripts are available. Home-schooled students must submit a brief written description of the subjects covered, materials used, and some evaluation of the student's progress.)
- ___ 4. A copy of standardized test score results taken within the last two years
- ___ 5. A letter of pastoral reference from someone who could evaluate your student's spiritual walk
- ___ 6. A letter of reference from a former teacher. Home-schooled students may submit a reference from someone other than a parent who could evaluate your student's academic potential.
- ___ 7. A non-refundable application fee must accompany all applications:
\$50 fee on or before June 15, \$100 fee June 16-July 31, \$200 fee after August 1

For Part-time Students - Please complete the parent section of the application. On a separate sheet of paper, indicate the classes your student is interested in taking at Covenant. Tell us whether you prefer those classes to be scheduled in the morning or afternoon. Include the non-refundable application fee of \$50, on or before June 15, \$100 fee June 16- July 31, \$200 fee after August 1.

All applications will be screened by the admissions committee. Qualified applicants for full-time status will be asked to come to the school with their parents for a personal interview with an administrator. The administration has the right to waive one or more of the above requirements and grant a probationary admission should extenuating circumstances merit. Students will be scheduled for classes when signed parental commitment agreements are received. Applications for financial assistance may be obtained from the school; they should be completed and submitted by the parents after the student has been accepted and parental commitment agreements are received.
