

## WHAT/WHO DOES GOD HATE?

### WHOEVER HE WANTS

Rom 9:<sup>13</sup> Just as it is written: “Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated.”

Mal 1:<sup>2</sup> “I have loved you,” says the LORD.

“But you ask, ‘How have you loved us?’

“Was not Esau Jacob’s brother?” the LORD says. “Yet I have loved Jacob, <sup>3</sup> but Esau I have hated, and I have turned his mountains into a wasteland and left his inheritance to the desert jackals.”

### PEOPLE WHO DO WRONG

Psalms 5:<sup>4</sup> You are not a God who takes pleasure in evil; with you the wicked cannot dwell. <sup>5</sup> The arrogant cannot stand in your presence; you *hate all who do wrong*. <sup>6</sup> You destroy those who tell lies; bloodthirsty and deceitful men the LORD abhors.

Hosea 9:<sup>15</sup> “Because of all their wickedness in Gilgal, I *hated* them there. Because of their sinful deeds, I will drive them out of my house. I will no longer love them; all their leaders are rebellious.

Psalms 11:<sup>5</sup> The LORD examines the righteous, but the wicked and those who love violence his soul *hates*. <sup>6</sup> On the wicked he will rain fiery coals and burning sulfur; a scorching wind will be their lot. <sup>7</sup> For the LORD is righteous, he loves justice; upright men will see his face.

Proverbs 6:<sup>6</sup> There are *six things the LORD hates*, seven that are *detestable* to him:

<sup>17</sup> haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, <sup>18</sup> a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, <sup>19</sup> a false witness who pours out lies and a man who stirs up dissension among brothers.

Deuteronomy 25:<sup>16</sup> For the LORD your God *detests* anyone who does these things, anyone who deals dishonestly.

Psalms 5:<sup>6</sup> You destroy those who tell lies; bloodthirsty and deceitful men the LORD *abhors*.

Deuteronomy 22:<sup>5</sup> A woman must not wear men’s clothing, nor a man wear women’s clothing, for the LORD your God *detests* anyone who does this.

Proverbs 3:<sup>32</sup> for the LORD *detests* a perverse man but takes the upright into his confidence.

Proverbs 11:<sup>20</sup> The LORD *detests* men of perverse heart but he delights in those whose ways are blameless.

Deuteronomy 23:<sup>18</sup> You must not bring the earnings of a female prostitute or of a male prostitute into the house of the LORD your God to pay any vow, because the LORD your God *detests* them both.

Proverbs 16:<sup>5</sup> The LORD *detests* all the proud of heart. Be sure of this: They will not go unpunished.

### IMPORPER BEHAVIOR OR THOUGHTS

Isaiah 61:8 “For I, the LORD, love justice; I *hate* robbery and iniquity.

Jer 44:<sup>2</sup> “This is what the LORD Almighty, the God of Israel, says: ... <sup>4</sup> Again and again I sent my servants the prophets, who said, ‘Do not do this detestable thing that I *hate!*’

Zech 8:<sup>16</sup> These are the things you are to do: Speak the truth to each other, and render true and sound judgment in your courts; <sup>17</sup> do not plot evil against your neighbor, and do not love to swear falsely. I *hate* all this,” declares the LORD.

Malachi 2:<sup>16</sup> “I *hate* divorce,” says the LORD God of Israel, “and I hate a man’s covering himself with violence as well as with his garment,” says the LORD Almighty. So guard yourself in your spirit, and do not break faith.

Rev 2:<sup>6</sup> But you have this in your favor: You hate the *practices* of the Nicolaitans, which I also *hate*.

Amos 6:<sup>8</sup> The Sovereign LORD has sworn by himself—the LORD God Almighty declares: “I *abhor* the *pride* of Jacob and detest his fortresses; I will deliver up the city and everything in it.”

Proverbs 12:<sup>22</sup> The LORD *detests* *lying lips*, but he delights in men who are truthful.

Proverbs 15:<sup>9</sup> The LORD *detests* the *way* of the wicked but he loves those who pursue righteousness.

Proverbs 15:<sup>26</sup> The LORD *detests* the *thoughts* of the wicked, but those of the pure are pleasing to him.

Proverbs 17:<sup>15</sup> Acquitting the guilty and condemning the innocent—the LORD *detests* them both.

### IMPROPER WORSHIP

Isaiah 1:<sup>14</sup> Your New Moon festivals and your appointed feasts my soul *hates*. They have become a burden to me; I am weary of bearing them. <sup>15</sup> When you spread out your hands in prayer, I will hide my eyes from you; even if you offer many prayers, I will not listen. Your hands are full of blood;

Amos 5:<sup>21</sup> “I *hate*, I despise your religious feasts; I cannot stand your assemblies.

Deut 12:<sup>31</sup> You must not worship the LORD your God in their way, because in worshiping their gods, they do all kinds of detestable things the LORD *hates*. ... <sup>32</sup> See that you do all I command you; do not add to it or take away from it.

Deut 16:<sup>21</sup> Do not set up any wooden Asherah pole beside the altar you build to the LORD your God, <sup>22</sup> and do not erect a sacred stone, for these the LORD your God *hates*.

Proverbs 15:<sup>8</sup> The LORD *detests* the sacrifice of the wicked, but the prayer of the upright pleases him.
